

Take Medicine Seriously

Always Read the Label

Identify the active ingredient

- Do not take more than the recommended dose
- Do not take more than one product containing the same active ingredient



Prescription drugs containing acetaminophen are sometimes labeled APAP. APAP is an abbreviation for acetaminophen. Do not take more than one acetaminophen-containing product. Talk to your doctor if you are not sure if a drug contains acetaminophen.



Check your other medicines:

Make sure they do not contain the same active ingredient.
